This letter is in response to your communication of December 9, 2014, wherein the Northeast Wisconsin Building Trades Council requested that the NMAPC grant authorization for Presidents Day (Federal), to be recognized as a floating holiday and celebrated on the Friday after Thanksgiving Day.

Pursuant to Article XI, paragraph 3 of the National Maintenance Agreements, you are hereby granted authorization to celebrate the floating holiday in lieu of Presidents Day (Federal) on the Friday after Thanksgiving Day commencing in the 2015 calendar year, for all work performed under the National Maintenance Agreements and that are within the geographical jurisdiction of the Northeast Wisconsin Building Trades Council.

Please be advised that the application of the floating holiday to the Friday after Thanksgiving Day will remain in effect for future calendar years unless this office is otherwise notified in a timely fashion by your Building Trades Council. Be further advised that as a result of this action, Presidents Day (Federal), which had previously been considered as a holiday, will now be considered as a regular work day for all work performed under the National Maintenance Agreements within your geographical jurisdiction.

It is strongly recommended that, in order to avoid any confusion and due to the timing of this request, you contact the affected owners and contractors currently performing work in your Council's jurisdiction of your Council's intention relative to this change in the floating holiday.
