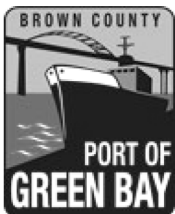

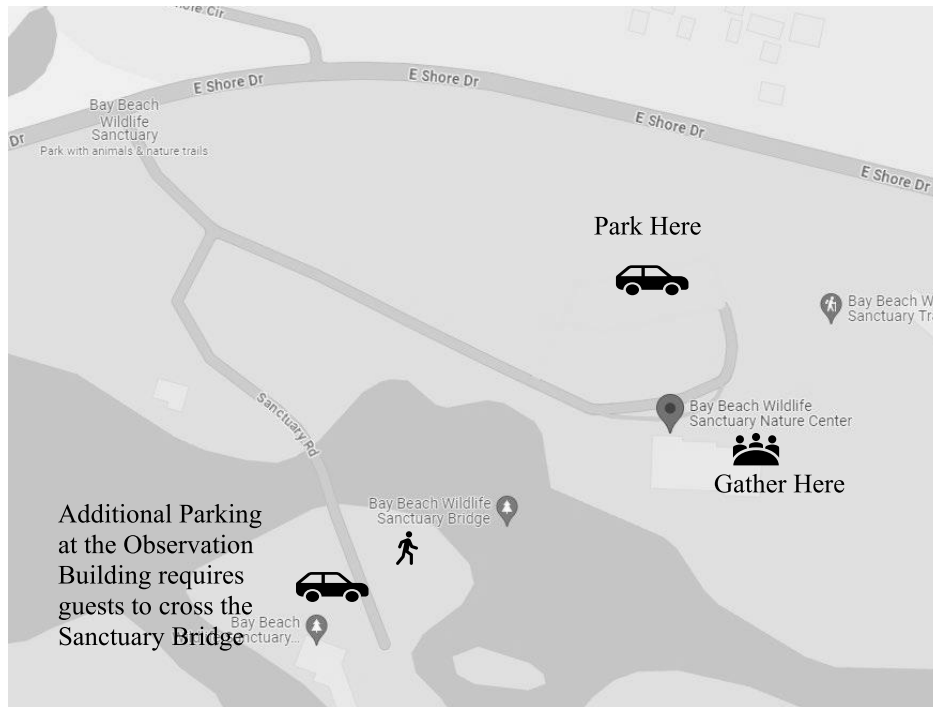

Directions to Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary

From Milwaukee Area: North on I-43 to Green Bay, Take Exit 187 for East Shore Drive, Right onto South East Shore Drive, Right into the Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary, Continue Left towards Nature Center, Parking will be on the Left.

From Fox Valley: North on US 41 to US 43 in Green Bay, Use the Right two lanes to take Exit 170 A-B for I-43 S, Take Exit 187 for East Shore Drive, Left onto East Shore Drive, Right into the Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary, Continue Left towards Nature Center, Parking will be on the Left.

From Northern WI and Michigan Upper Peninsula: South on US 41 to Exit 170B, Take Exit 170B to merge onto I-43 S, Take Exit 187 for East Shore Drive, Left onto East Shore Drive, Right into the Bay Beach Wildlife Sanctuary, Continue Left towards Nature Center, Parking will be on the Left.
