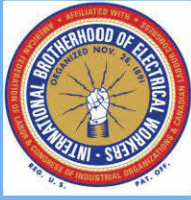

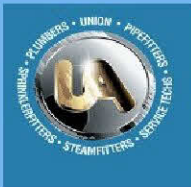

Apprenticeship Pay\$

When you're accepted into a certified apprenticeship program, you receive classroom training from instructors with practical experience, PLUS you get paid while you're learning on the job! The average apprentice earns \$18/hr. plus benefits during on the job training.

Apprenticeship training lasts 3-5 years depending on the trade. Admission tests are required for most of the trades and candidates with high school courses in general math, algebra, geometry, science and mechanical drawing are the most desirable.
